
GENERAL ORDER NO. 10

ESTABLISHING PRETRIAL SERVICES


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pretrial Services, as defined in Public Law 97-267 (18 U.S.C. 3152 et seq.), be established in the probation office of this district, under the supervision of the Chief Probation Officer.

The function of Pretrial Services shall be to provide assistance to the Court in setting bail bonds on persons accused of offenses, to supervise persons released on bail when required by the Court, and to provide other services enumerated in 18 U.S.C. 3154. Pretrial Services reports submitted to the Court shall be used only for the purposes of bail determination, and shall be made available for review by the accused, or his attorney, and the attorney for the Government.
