


IN THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT

O R D E R

On this 2nd day of March, 1989, it is ordered that the order signed by this court and entered on May 7, 1984, permitting the posting of collateral in lieu of the appearance of the offender within the territorial jurisdiction of the United States Magistrates for the Western District of Arkansas and which specifically provides that collateral may be posted in lieu of appearance by the person charged with violation of National Park Service Regulations under Title 36, Chapter I, Code of Federal Regulations, be and hereby is amended in that the sections, numbers, offenses, and collateral amounts as set out in part four, Vehicle and Traffic Safety, of the May 7, 1984, order are set aside and in lieu thereof the attached schedule is substituted. The attached schedule reflects the sections, numbers, offenses, and collateral amounts which will heretofore be applied for violation of the regulations set forth at 36 C.F.R. § 4.
