Upon the execution of a Magistrate's Complaint or a Petition for a Warrant for an Offender

Under Pretrial or Supervised Release, all papers in connection therewith will be filed with the Clerk

of Court. The Clerk will maintain these records, including the issuance of a warrant for arrest,

under seal until a warrant for arrest is returned executed and/or the defendant appears before a

judicial officer on the Complaint or Petition.

After the sealed warrant is returned executed and/or the defendant appears before a judicial

officer on the Complaint or Petition, the Clerk will maintain these records as public records.

The United States Marshals Service is granted authority to serve a sealed warrant on the

offender and to enter the warrant into the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) or other law

enforcement system.
