(revised May 14, 1997)


It appearing that, to insure their safety, the Probation Officers of this Court on occasion require the use of firearms in the execution of their duties.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that when qualified and when specifically authorized by the Chief U. S. Probation Officer, and in compliance with such other conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts generally, and the policies of the WD/AR specifically, each regularly appointed Probation Officer of this Court is authorized to carry a firearm for personal protection and for the protection of fellow officers during the performance of his or her duties.

This order shall take effect May 14, 1997 and shall continue until further action of this Court.
